

Childhood and adolescence can be a difficult and challenging time. St Brendan's will be offering counselling services to children at school through on Psych.

onPsych offers services to students, their families and the school community a no out of pocket expenses (bulk billing) service. This is done under a range of programs, including the GP Mental Health Care Plan (MHCP) and National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS).

The MHCP will entitle the child, adolescent or family member up to 20 therapeutic (counselling sessions) per year with the psychologist. NDIS services differ based on individual plans.
